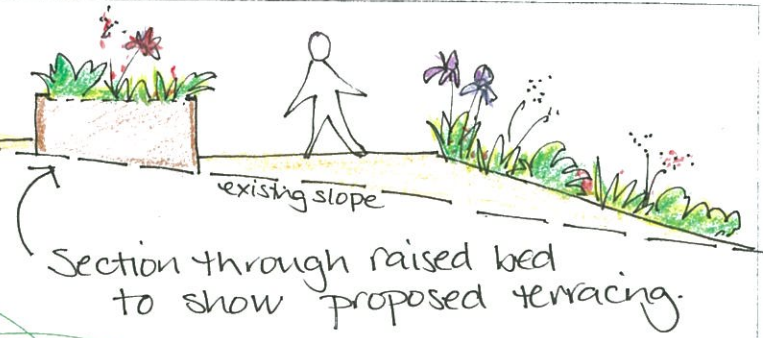


Sensory garden planted for colour, scent, texture & sound. Bredon gravel path, terraced into slope, gives wide, level access from end of Avenue to Pavilion with space for seats.

Stone roundel at end of wall with spiral motif to echo detail on fountain. Wall rebuilt & rendered to match raised bed.

Ornamental drinking fountain with spiral motif in stonework



Section through raised bed to show proposed terracing.

Waves of ornamental grasses with seasonal planting in between eg: annual wildflowers for movement & interest.

Existing raised bed approx 1m ht with access to either side.

Larger shrubs or small trees with textured bark & foliage
